Since early in 2001 LLES has been campaigning for energy saving solutions to the problems facing us. As the account below proves, LLES has been on the cutting edge of environmental issues in mid Wales. We have not been afraid to be bold and while our ambition has not always met with instant success (Concerto European Funding bid, hydro-electric scheme, bio-gas scheme) we have learned and grown through those experiences, in readiness for the time when our solutions are recognised as essential.
